Why Daily Meal Counts Claims?

 For the purpose of data integrity across systems between the sponsoring organization and the state agency

 Streamlined processes of claiming between both the IL Centers and Homes processes within the CACFP in WINS



Why Daily Meal Counts Claims?

 Phase One: Practice learning during the slow roll out of the daily meal count batch file claiming in order to support preparedness for the complete system change.

• **Phase Two:** Submitting monthly claims solely with the use of *daily meal count* batch file data, without the claim entry summary as part of the claim submission process.



Sponsor Responsibility In Claim Success

- Ensuring the accuracy of the provider site information.
- Sponsor providers' files must be uploaded as a .CSV file and updated to WINS regularly, minimally at least twice a month.
- Sponsors are responsible for their own data's accuracy upon upload into WINS
- Sponsors should be the first to assess what is correct or incorrect in their data first, before sending to ISBE
